Atlantic Richfield to continue demolition and disposal activities at the Butte Reduction Works

1. WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Atlantic Richfield will continue demolition at Butte Reduction Works (BRW) to support remediation of BRW and subsequent construction of the Silver Bow Creek Conservation Area. Construction crews will demolish segments of the slag wall immediately adjacent to Montana Street, the foundation of the former smelter stack, and the remainder of the furnace foundation. Future waste excavation, stream reconstruction, capping, and installation of groundwater controls won't be completed until remedial design plans are reviewed and approved by EPA, in consultation with DEQ.

2. WHEN IS THIS HAPPENING?

Demolition will begin in early February and is expected to conclude by late spring of 2025.

3. WHERE ARE THE DEBRIS BEING TAKEN?

Demolition debris and limited impacted soils will be hauled directly to the existing Butte Mine Waste Repository (BMWR) via approved haul routes (please see map below). All loads traveling to the BMWR will be covered.

4. SHOULD I EXPECT ANY IMPACTS IN MY NEIGHBORHOOD?

The Butte Reduction Works is in an industrial area west of Montana Street, between Interstate 90 and Centennial Ave. Demolition of the slag wall will take place adjacent to Montana Street. The work will be highly visible from Montana Street. Noise from heavy equipment will be heard in the project area. Residents should expect construction traffic on portions of Montana Street, George Street, Kaw Avenue, West Front Street, Centennial Avenue, Excelsior Avenue, Ryan Road, and Alexander Street. Traffic control signage will be installed to warn motorists of activity in the area.

5. WILL THE PROJECT AREA BE MONITORED FOR DUST?

The contractor will use water to suppress dust at the project site. Air quality will be monitored in accordance with an Air Monitoring Plan, reviewed and approved by EPA, in consultation with DEQ.

6. WHO IS DOING THE WORK?

Jacobs, Envirocon, and other contractors will perform the work on behalf of Atlantic Richfield. This project is being conducted in coordination with Butte-Silver Bow, under the oversight of EPA.
